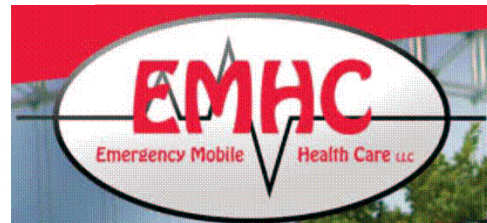


DIVERSITY Memphis Walks
